We would like to present our latest outreach, "A Small Room". The affordable housing shortage in our area creates a hardship for many, particularly single adults trying to rise above the circumstances they face.



A small room...There are times when a person needs a safe, quiet place to stay. In our experience within the community we've found that there are some in need of such a place to recover and relaunch. We have eight rooms that have been designated for such needs. Inspired by the Biblical story from 2 Kings 4 when a prophet needed such a place, a Shunammite woman said, "Let's make a small room for him, with a bed and a table, a chair and a lamp." (2 Kings 4:10) We've also added a microwave and a small refrigerator. There is also a larger common area furnished with a stove, full sink, pots and pans, dishes and utensils. In addition, there is a comfortable living room setting with a television for playing videos and a nice selection of board games.

## A Small Room Includes:

A safe, clean room including a Bed with pillows and linens, chair and one set of towels.

A private or semi-private bathroom, with a shower, stool

and sink. There will be an initial supply of paper products.

A microwave and small refrigerator.

A private heater. Each building has a thermostat which has a permanent setting. Additional heaters are not allowed. All heaters, AC units and fans must be turned off if you are not present.

A dresser and a small rack for hanging clothes.

One or two chairs.

A bench for sitting or luggage.

There will be one key for the room. This is not to be duplicated and is restricted for your use only.

There is a community kitchen/dining area with living room space. You may use stove, dishes, etc. however, you must wash and return items after each use. Clean up after yourself...leaving the area better than you found it.

The community room has couches and a TV with a video player. There is no cable. Movies must not be rated higher than M (Mature).

## Requirements for our Guests:

Whether a person is recovering from substance abuse, financial disaster, or other setbacks, our desire is to provide a place of peace, unconditional love and new beginnings. Our rooms are reserved for guests referred to us in collaboration with Codington County Welfare, Codington County Drug Court, and Court Services Officers, Parole Services with South Dakota Department of Corrections, and Inter-lakes Community Action Partnership (ICAP.) Guests are not to have past convictions, or current charges of violent or sexual crimes.

Requirement for stay include having a mentor, attendance/participation in recovery meetings required by a Court Service Officer or Parole Agent, and case management through ICAP.

Applicants must have a desire or "want to" for a better life, free from life-controlling struggles such as alcohol or substance abuse.

Accountability is key! Therefore, each guest will have a relationship with an approved mentor and will maintain close contact in order to have support through their recovery journey.

Guests will be required to attend self-help meetings, including church and/or Bible studies.


